However exams can be beneficial especially in the higher grades where from Grade 6 upwards, pupils can earn UCAS points for passing exams.

At JT Music, we are a team. Any new resources created by teachers are shared amongst all of us. This includes ideas for new games, worksheets, lesson structures and much more. We also take the time to share



other teachers' lessons to pick up any new ideas or teaching approaches that we might not have thought of ourselves. This way, no matter what teacher a pupil has, they will receive the best resources and materials. These sharing methods allow us to constantly update the way we teach to make sure we give our pupils the best possible

experience.

We have used the internet to our advantage to create new ways to help our pupils.
